Mizell

Establishes the Louisiana-Ireland Trade Commission.

Provides for a 12-member commission appointed as follows:

- (1) One member representing the restaurant industry, appointed by the president of the Senate.
- (2) One member representing the oil and gas industry, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives.
- (3) Two members of the Senate, appointed by the president of the Senate.
- (4) Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives.
- (5) Six members appointed by the governor; which shall include at least one representative from a public institution of higher education and at least two public members representing Irish-American communities or interests.

Provides that the commission is established to reinvent the economies of Louisiana and Ireland for success, build a strong commercial link between the state and the country and to propose recommendations and specific proposals for legislation. The commission's findings and recommendations are to be submitted by March 1, 2026.

Provides that the commission shall terminate on the date of the submission of its report or August 1, 2026, whichever occurs first.
