| 2 | To amend and reenact R.S. 33:2740.45, relative to Morehouse Parish; to increase the |
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| 3 | maximum rate of ad valorem taxes the governing authority of the parish is authorized |
| 4 | to levy for public cemeteries; to provide for the use of the proceeds of the taxes; to |
| 5 | provide for the use of the proceeds of taxes from prior tax years; to provide for an |
| 6 | effective date; and to provide for related matters. |
| 7 | Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published |
| 8 | as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of |
| 9 | Louisiana. |
| 10 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: |
| 11 | Section 1. R.S. 33:2740.45 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: |
| 12 | §2740.45. Public cemetery maintenance <u>cemeteries</u> ; ad valorem tax; Morehouse |
| 13 | Parish |
| 14 | A. In addition to the ad valorem tax authorized by R.S. 33:2740.1, the |
| 15 | governing authority of Morehouse Parish may levy ad valorem taxes in any ward in |
| 16 | Morehouse Parish not to exceed two three mills, to be used for the acquisition, |
| 17 | improvement, maintenance, and upkeep of public cemeteries located in such ward. |
| 18 | The taxes shall be levied only after the question of the imposition of the taxes has |
| 19 | been submitted to the qualified electors of such ward at an election to be conducted |
| 20 | in accordance with the general election laws of the state of Louisiana and a majority |
| 21 | of those voting in the election have voted in favor of the imposition of the taxes. |

AN ACT

1 B. In addition to any previously authorized purposes, the governing authority 2 of Morehouse Parish may use unexpended proceeds of any tax levied pursuant to this 3 Section in tax years prior to 2025 for the acquisition and improvement of public 4 cemeteries located in any such ward. 5 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 6 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 7 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 8 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 9 effective on the day following such approval.
