## ACT 7 (HB 10) 2025 Regular Session Boyer

Existing law requires a reemployed retiree of the La. State Employees' Retirement System to meet the following requirements to be exempt from any benefit increase, suspension, or reduction during reemployment:

- (1) Retired for one year.
- (2) Is eligible to receive his full retirement benefit.
- (3) Appointed by the governor to fill an unclassified civil service position.

<u>Prior law</u> additionally required the reemployed retiree to have at least 30 years of service credit to be eligible for the exemption.

<u>New law</u> reduces the service credit requirement to at least 25 years.

<u>New law</u> requires that any cost of <u>new law</u> be funded with additional employer contributions in compliance with <u>existing constitution</u> (Art. X, Sec. 29(F)).

Effective August 1, 2025.
