Price

Existing law provides that any person participating in the State Police Retirement System previously employed in any law enforcement agency of the federal government or of any other state or any political subdivision of another state, where such service is not creditable in any public retirement or pension system, fund, or plan in this or any other state or of the federal government, may purchase service credit in the system for the employment by paying all actuarial costs of the purchase as determined by the system actuary.

Prior law required that the member have at least 10 years of service credit, with a membership that begins on or before June 30, 2008.

New law decreases the required amount of current service credit a person must have to purchase previous employment service credit from 10 years to six months and removes the membership enrollment start date condition.

Effective June 4, 2025.
