

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 94 (SB 32)**

New law provides for limitation of liability to agricultural producers and landowners that utilize gypsum and suppliers of gypsum to agricultural producers.

New law requires all of the following be executed to limit liability:

- (1) All requirements of new law and any rules or regulations adopted and are complied with.
- (2) The agricultural producer obtains gypsum at no cost from a source where the gypsum is being stored as a byproduct of a manufacturing process.
- (3) Agricultural producers use gypsum that has been analyzed and passes analytical tolerances established by the dept. on his land or with written authorization from the landowner.

New law provides that tolerances will be established using the Conservation Practice Standard, Amending Soil Properties with Gypsum Products from the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture and any regulations by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency pertaining to soil amendments as guides.

Effective August 1, 2025.
