<u>Existing law</u> provides for the La. Duck License, Stamp, and Print Program to fund projects to protect and preserve migratory waterfowl recreation and tourism in the state through the sale of duck licenses and duck stamps and prints and provides for the administration of the program.

<u>Prior law</u> created fees for both resident and nonresident duck stamps, as part of an earlier law that required the purchase of a resident or nonresident duck stamp, in addition to a resident or nonresident duck license, to take migratory waterfowl.

Existing law provides that the purchase of annual duck stamps and prints are not required for taking waterfowl, nor do they convey any privileges related to hunting, taking, possessing, or transporting ducks in the state.

<u>New law</u> removes <u>prior law</u> as an obsolete provision related to law which was previously repealed.

Effective August 1, 2025.
