<u>Existing law</u> requires the office of motor vehicles collect, in addition to any fee authorized by law, a handling charge of \$12 for each duplicate Class "D" and "E" driver's license transaction.

<u>New law</u> specifies that an applicant seeking to update a driver's license to become REAL ID compliant prior to the renewal eligibility of the driver's license is exempt from the fee imposed in <u>existing law</u> for the issuance of a duplicate license. Additionally, requires the applicant pay the handling fee as set forth in <u>existing law</u>.

New law specifies that the REAL ID exemption terminates on June 30, 2026.

Effective August 1, 2025.
