ACT 130 (HB 54) 2025 Regular Session Horton

<u>Existing law</u> provides for a program administered by the Bd. of Regents for the designation of a postsecondary education institution that meets certain requirements relative to serving military and veteran students. <u>New law</u> changes name of such designation <u>from</u> "Governor's Military and Veteran Friendly Campus" <u>to</u> "Purple Star Campus."

<u>New law</u> adds the following to the minimum criteria an institution is required to meet to qualify for the designation:

- (1) Designate a faculty or staff member to serve as a military liaison.
- (2) Maintain a section on its website highlighting resources for military students and their families.
- (3) Maintain a student-led transition program to acclimate military students to campus and the wider community.
- (4) Offer professional development opportunities to faculty and staff relative to issues unique to military students.

New law increases the duration of the designation from two years to three years.

<u>New law</u> provides that all "Governor's Military and Veteran Friendly Campus" designations terminate on the effective date of <u>new law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2025.
