Existing law provides that all public officers shall take and subscribe to the oath or affirmation required by existing constitution (Art. X, Sec. 30). Authorizes certain officials to administer the oath or affirmation of all state officers. Requires the oath or affirmation to be deposited and recorded by the secretary of state.

Existing law provides that oaths and affirmations for all parish officers be recorded by the clerk of court where the oath or affirmation was administered.

Existing law provides that clerks of district courts charge a fee for filing and recording documents.

New law provides that the oath or affirmation shall be recorded at no cost to the official taking the oath or affirmation.

Effective August 1, 2025.
