<u>Existing law</u> provides that all public officers shall take and subscribe to the oath or affirmation required by <u>existing constitution</u> (Art. X, Sec. 30). Authorizes certain officials to administer the oath or affirmation of all state officers. Requires the oath or affirmation to be deposited and recorded by the secretary of state.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that oaths and affirmations for all parish officers be recorded by the clerk of court where the oath or affirmation was administered.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that clerks of district courts charge a fee for filing and recording documents.

 $\underline{\text{New law}}$ provides that the oath or affirmation shall be recorded at no cost to the official taking the oath or affirmation.

Effective August 1, 2025.
