## ACT 161 (HB 213) 2025 Regular Session

St. Blanc

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes any local public school board to sell any individual computing device used by a student for classwork which is not used and is not needed in the operation of any school or schools within its jurisdiction.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the proceeds from such sale to be used for general fund expenditures of the school board. <u>New law</u> further authorizes proceeds to be used for the acquisition, maintenance, or improvement of technology resources for the school or school district.

<u>New law</u> authorizes a school board to trade or participate in a buyback program when alienating individual computing devices.

<u>New law</u> requires a school board to securely erase all student, employee, and school and district data or make it inaccessible before alienating a device.

Effective August 1, 2025.
