ACT 161 (HB 213)

2025 Regular Session

Existing law authorizes any local public school board to sell any individual computing device used by a student for classwork which is not used and is not needed in the operation of any school or schools within its jurisdiction.

Existing law requires the proceeds from such sale to be used for general fund expenditures of the school board. New law further authorizes proceeds to be used for the acquisition, maintenance, or improvement of technology resources for the school or school district.

New law authorizes a school board to trade or participate in a buyback program when alienating individual computing devices.

New law requires a school board to securely erase all student, employee, and school and district data or make it inaccessible before alienating a device.

Effective August 1, 2025.
