<u>Existing law</u> provides that a qualified elector may bring an action objecting to candidacy under certain circumstances. Further provides for other contests and challenges.

<u>New law</u> requires the court to assess court costs and attorney fees upon a determination that a candidate knowingly attested to false information in a notice of candidacy. Further provides that the court may impose further sanctions if deemed appropriate.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 4, 2025).
