Bayham

Creates the America 250 La. State Commission to work jointly with the federal America250 commission to help plan and coordinate the celebration of the semiquincentennial anniversary of the United States of America. Provides that the commission is the successor to the commission created by HCR No. 96 of the 2022 R.S. and HCR No. 50 of the 2023 R.S.

Provides that the commission is composed of any members of the federal commission residing in the state of La. as well as the following members:

- (1) The governor, or his designee.
- (2) The executive director of the Governor's Office of Indian Affairs shall appoint one member.
- (3) The lieutenant governor, or his designee.
- (4) The lieutenant governor shall appoint three members.
- (5) The assistant secretary of the La. Dept. of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, office of tourism, shall appoint one member.
- (6) The assistant secretary of the La. Dept. of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, office of cultural development, shall appoint one member.
- (7) The assistant secretary of the Dept. of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, office of state museums, shall appoint one member.
- (8) The secretary of state, or his designee.
- (9) The state archivist shall appoint one member.
- (10) The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall appoint one member.
- (11) The commissioner of higher education shall appoint one member.
- (12) The president of the La. Historical Association shall appoint one member.
- (13) The president of the La. Association of Museums shall appoint one member.
- (14) The governor of the Order of the Granaderos y Damas de Galvez shall appoint one member.
- (15) The president of the La. Endowment for the Humanities shall appoint one member.
- (16) The speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two members.
- (17) The president of the Senate shall appoint two members.
- (18) The state superintendent of education shall appoint one member.

Effective until July 4, 2027.
