

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 135 (HB 90)**

**2025 Regular Session**

**Hebert**

Relative to restaurant reservation fraud, new law defines "food service establishment" and "third-party restaurant reservation platform".

New law provides for what a third-party restaurant reservation platform shall not do unless there is a written agreement between that third-party restaurant reservation platform and the food service establishment authorizing it to do so.

New law provides that the attorney general may impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$1,000 for each violation of new law. New law provides that civil penalties collected under proposed law shall be used to promote consumer protection and education.

New law provides that for violations of new law the attorney general may seek restitution from a third-party restaurant reservation platform to a person who purchased a reservation not exceeding the amount actually paid by the person.

Effective August 1, 2025.
