**Taylor**

Existing law prohibits insurers from increasing the premiums charged for automobile liability insurance policies based solely on the grounds that policyholders have attained the age of 65 or older.

New law retains existing law and subjects any insurer in violation of new law to a penalty or regulatory action of the commissioner in accordance with the La. Insurance Code.

Effective August 1, 2025.
