<u>Existing law</u> prohibits insurers from increasing the premiums charged for automobile liability insurance policies based solely on the grounds that policyholders have attained the age of 65 or older.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and subjects any insurer in violation of <u>new law</u> to a penalty or regulatory action of the commissioner in accordance with the La. Insurance Code.

Effective August 1, 2025.
