Crews

New law creates the Energy Utility Reporting Transparency Act.

New law defines "annual consumption report", "commission", and "energy utility".

<u>New law</u> provides that the Public Service Commission (commission) shall annually publish a list on whether an energy utility offers property owners with multiple meters the option to request an annual consumption report at no additional cost.

New law provides that the commission shall publish and distribute the list required by <u>new law</u>.

<u>New law</u> provides that the commission shall publish the list required by <u>proposed law</u> covering the previous calendar year by March 1 of each year.

<u>New law</u> provides that energy utilities shall report to the commission annually, by January 15, whether they offer property owners with multiple meters the option to request an annual consumption report.

<u>New law</u> provides that the commission shall promulgate any rules and regulations necessary for the collection and publication of the information outlined in <u>new law</u>.

<u>New law</u> provides that <u>new law</u> shall not require energy utilities to provide an annual consumption report, but energy utilities shall disclose to the commission if they do or do not provide this service.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 24, 2025).
