Abstract: Provides for retroactive application of the uniform 10-point grading school requirement to the grades of students who were enrolled in the ninth grade during the 2023-2024 school year.

Present law requires each public school governing authority to use a uniform 10-point grading scale. Present law became effective on Aug. 1, 2024, and was therefore applicable beginning with the 2024-2025 school year.

Proposed law provides that present law has retroactive application to students who were enrolled in the ninth grade during the 2023-2024 school year (the graduating class of the 2026-2027 school year). Requires the recalculation of grades earned by ninth graders during that school year using the present law 10-point scale.
