Abstract: Requires a person making a motion to expunge arrest information to provide additional documentation to the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information.

Present law provides for motions to expunge.

Proposed law retains present law and requires someone making a motion to expunge arrest information to also provide bills of information, court minutes, a pardon copy, and a motion to set aside or dismiss, if they exist, to the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information in addition to the motion to expunge.

Proposed law requires someone making a motion to expunge arrest information to provide, if applicable, a criminal background check, a letter from the district attorney for a fee waiver, certifications from the district attorney regarding criminal charges and pretrial diversion programs, sex offender notification waiver, and a determination of innocence.
