





Present constitution provides that if the proposal is approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, the governor shall proclaim it to be the Constitution of Louisiana.

Proposed constitutional amendment instead provides that the proposal shall be ratified by a majority of the electors voting thereon and in no fewer than 3/4 of the parishes.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held November 3, 2026.
