AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1231.1(A)(2), relative to medical malpractice; to define authority for purposes of medical malpractice; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 40:1231.1(A)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1231.1. Definitions and general applications

A. As used in this Part:

* * *

(2) "Authority" means the Residual Malpractice Insurance Authority established under ~~Section 1231.7~~ **R.S. 40:1231.7**.
