CONGRESS. Provides for the redistricting of Louisiana congressional districts. (See Act)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 18:1276 and to repeal R.S. 18:1276.1, relative to congressional districts; to  
3 provide for the redistricting of Louisiana's congressional districts; to provide with  
4 respect to positions and offices, other than congressional, which are based upon  
5 congressional districts; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for related  
6 matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 18:1276 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 **§1276. Congressional districts**

10 **Louisiana shall be divided into six congressional districts, and the**  
11 **qualified electors of each district shall elect one representative to the United**  
12 **States House of Representatives. The districts shall be composed as follows:**

5           Section 2. R.S. 18:1276.1 is hereby repealed.

6           Section 3.(A) The precincts referenced in this Act are those contained in the file  
7           named "2026 Precinct Shapefiles (1-27-2026)" available on the website of the Legislature  
8           of Louisiana on the effective date of this Section. The 2026 Precinct Shapefiles are based  
9           upon those Voting Districts (VTDs) contained in the 2020 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line  
10          Shapefiles for the state of Louisiana as those files have been modified and validated through  
11          the data verification program of the Louisiana Senate and the Louisiana House of  
12          Representatives to represent precinct changes submitted through January 27, 2026, to the  
13          Legislature of Louisiana by parish governing authorities pursuant to the provisions of R.S.  
14          18:532 and 532.1.

15          (B) When a precinct referenced in this Act has been subdivided by action of the  
16          parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish  
17          governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with the provisions of R.S.  
18          18:532.1, the enumeration in this Act of the general precinct designation shall include all  
19          nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof, however such subdivisions may be  
20          designated.

21          (C) The territorial limits of the districts as provided in this Act shall continue in  
22          effect until changed by law regardless of any subsequent change made to the precincts by  
23          the parish governing authority.

24          Section 4. The provisions of this Act shall not reduce the term of office of any person  
25          holding any position or office on the effective date of this Section for which the appointment  
26          or election is based upon a congressional district as composed pursuant to R.S. 18:1276.1.  
27          Any position or office that is filled by appointment or election based upon a congressional  
28          district and that is to be filled after January 3, 2029, shall be appointed or elected from a  
29          district as it is described in Section 1 of this Act.

1 Section 5.(A) Solely for the purposes of qualifying for election and the conduct of  
2 the election of representatives to the United States Congress at the regularly scheduled  
3 election for representatives to the congress in 2028, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act  
4 shall become effective upon signature of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the  
5 governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the  
6 governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act  
7 is vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, the provisions of  
8 Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval for the  
9 purposes established in this Subsection.

10 (B) For subsequent elections of representatives to the United States Congress and for  
11 all other purposes, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective at noon on  
12 January 3, 2029.

13 (C) The provisions of Section 2 of this Act shall become effective at noon on January  
14 3, 2029.

15 (D) The provisions of this Section and Sections 3 and 4 of this Act shall become  
16 effective upon signature of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon  
17 expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided  
18 in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act is vetoed by the  
19 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, the provisions of this Section and  
20 Sections 3 and 4 of this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

DIGEST

SB 130 Original 2026 Regular Session Morris

Present U.S. Constitution (14th Amendment) provides that representatives in congress shall be apportioned among the several states according to their respective numbers, counting the whole number of persons in each state. The U.S. Supreme Court has held that the population of congressional districts in the same state must be as nearly equal in population as practicable.

Present law provides for six congressional districts based upon the 2020 federal decennial census.

Proposed law updates precincts for the current Act 2 of the 2024 1st E.S. congressional districts based upon the "2026 Precinct Shapefiles (1-27-2026)" and redraws district boundaries.

Proposed law provides that the new districts become effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action for election purposes only for the regular congressional elections in 2028. Retains present law districts based upon the 2020 census until noon on January 3, 2029, at which time present law is repealed and the new districts based upon the 2020 census, as established by proposed law, become effective for all other purposes.

Proposed law specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions are those precincts identified as Voting Districts (VTDs) contained in the file named "2026 Precinct Shapefiles (1-27-2026)" available on the La. Legislature's website. Specifies that the 2026 Precinct Shapefiles are based upon those Voting Districts (VTDs) contained in the 2020 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the state of Louisiana as those files have been modified and validated through the data verification program of the La. Legislature. Also specifies that if any such precinct has been subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with present law, the enumeration of the general precinct designation shall include all nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof. Further provides that the territorial limits of the districts as enacted shall continue in effect until changed by law regardless of any subsequent change made to the precincts by the parish governing authority.

Proposed law specifies that proposed law does not reduce the term of office of any person holding any position or office on the effective date of proposed law for which the appointment or election is based upon a congressional district as composed pursuant to present law. Specifies that any position or office filled after January 3, 2029, for which the appointment or election is based upon a congressional district shall be appointed or elected from a district as it is described in proposed law.

Population data in the summaries accompanying this digest are derived from 2020 Census Redistricting Data (Public Law 94-171), Summary File for Louisiana. Population data, statistical information, and maps are supplied for purposes of information and analysis and comprise no part of proposed law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action for election purposes only for the regular congressional elections in 2028; effective for all other purposes at noon on January 3, 2029.


