**Abstract:** Makes carbon dioxide sequestration illegal beneath private property without the property owner's consent, unless the property owner cannot be located.

Proposed law provides that carbon dioxide sequestration beneath private property without consent is illegal.

Proposed law provides an exception for instances where a property owner cannot be located after a reasonable search and good fath effort to find them by the storage facility owner or operator.
