HOUSE BILL NO. 355

BY REPRESENTATIVE WYBLE AND SENATOR MIZELL

HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of Louisiana Highway 10 from the Washington-Tangipahoa Parish line extending east to the Louisiana-Mississippi state line as the "Veterans Park Highway"

1 AN ACT

2 To designate a portion of Louisiana Highway 10 in Washington Parish as the "Veterans Park
3 Highway"; to provide for implementation; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. The portion of Louisiana Highway 10 beginning at the Washington-
6 Tangipahoa parish line and extending east to the Louisiana-Mississippi state line shall be
7 known and is hereby designated as the "Veterans Park Highway".

8 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed
9 to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation provided local or private
10 monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for material,
11 fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of the signage, not to exceed the sum of seven
12 hundred fifty dollars per sign.

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 10, beginning at the boundary between Washington and Tangipahoa Parishes and extending eastward to the state line between La. and MS., as the "Veterans Park Highway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the highway designation provided local or private monies are received by the DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of the signage, not to exceed the sum of \$750 per sign.
