Abstract: Creates the crime of reckless throwing from a parade float.

Proposed law prohibits a person from knowingly or negligently throwing an object from a parade float in a manner that is foreseeable to cause injury to another person.

Proposed law provides a fine of \$500 for any violation.

Proposed law provides a fine of up to \$1,000 and up to six months imprisonment for a violation that causes an injury as defined in present law (R.S. 14:2).

Proposed law provides a fine of at least \$2,000 and one to three years imprisonment for a violation that causes serious bodily injury as defined in present law (R.S. 14:2).
