Boudreaux

Present law prohibits any person other than a licensed financial institution from using certain terms and words as part of its name or title.

Proposed law retains present law and allows an FDIC-insured bank operating in the state to use a trade or assumed name different from its corporate name, as long as the corporate name is used together with the trade name and the bank complies with applicable federal laws and regulations.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
