AN ACT

To enact R.S. 13:1952.2, relative to the city court of Jeanerette; to provide relative to the territorial jurisdiction of the court; to provide relative to concurrent jurisdiction with the justice of the peace in certain circumstances; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 13:1952.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

**§1952.2 City court of Jeanerette; territorial jurisdiction; effect on justice of peace**

**The territorial jurisdiction of the city court of Jeanerette shall extend throughout the portions of Iberia Parish designated as Precincts 10-1, 10-4, 11-6, 12-1, 12-2, 12-3, 12-4 and the portion of Precinct 11-1 west of the shoreline of Lake Fausse Point. In such portions of those precincts that are outside of the city of Jeanerette, the court shall have jurisdiction concurrent with the justice of the peace in those cases in which the justice of the peace would have jurisdiction.**
