SEX OFFENSES. Provides that nondisclosure agreements involving victims of child sexual abuse are against public policy and unenforceable. (8/1/26)

1 AN ACT
2 To enact R.S. 9:2717.5, relative to requisites for a valid agreement; to prohibit nondisclosure
3 agreements involving victims of child sexual abuse; and to provide for related
4 matters.
5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6 Section 1. R.S. 9:2717.5 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7 **§2717.5. Nondisclosure agreements; victims of child sexual abuse**
8 **Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no agreement**
9 **involving a victim of child sexual abuse that prevents, or has the effect of**
10 **preventing, the victim from disclosing or discussing the child sexual abuse**
11 **involving the victim is judicially enforceable, and is null and void as against**
12 **public policy.**
