Miguez

Present law provides time limitations on the prosecution of noncapital offenses.

Proposed law removes the time limitations on the prosecution of the following offenses committed by an elected official while in office or by a public employee during his period of public employment:

- (1) Abuse of office.
- (2) Bribery of a candidate.
- (3) Bribery of voters.
- (4) Corrupt influencing.
- (5) Malfeasance in office.
- (6) Public bribery.

Proposed law otherwise retains present law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
