Proposed law requires public postsecondary education institutions that offer medical doctorate degrees to adopt policies that ensure any coursework offered in their curriculum for a medical degree or certificate assesses a student's performance based on the assignment of a letter grade of A, B, C, D, or F, with a plus or minus for each letter A through D, or another tiered system with at least four such designations.

Proposed law provides that policies must be adopted beginning in the 2026-2027 academic year.

Proposed law authorizes the Bd. of Regents to adopt policies that provide for civil penalties for violations to proposed law.

Proposed law provides for a severability clause.

Proposed law provides that the law will be known as the "Medical School Letter Grade Act".

Effective July 1, 2026.
