HB 729 Original

Abstract: Prohibits persons from leaving garbage and recycling receptacles in the right-of-way of a state road after the day of regularly scheduled collection and imposes a fine for noncompliance.

Proposed law requires that all garbage and recycling bins put in a state road right-of-way for regularly scheduled collection be removed by the end of collection day.

Proposed law provides that noncompliance with proposed law will subject a person to the following fines:

- (1) \$100 for a first offense.
- (2) \$200 for a second offense.
- (3) \$300 for a third or subsequent offense.

Proposed law authorizes any political subdivision, including the state, parishes, or municipalities, that maintains the right-of-way for a state road to enforce proposed law on those rights-of-way that it maintains.
