Abstract: Provides relative to the Louisiana Board of Chiropractic Examiners definitions for preceptor and preceptee and their duties and responsibilities.

Present law defines board, chiropractor duties, and the practice of chiropractic.

Proposed law adds definitions for preceptor and preceptee.

Proposed law provides for preceptors to delegate responsibilities and tasks to a preceptee, requires a preceptor to be licensed and in good standing in this state or another jurisdiction for five years, and be licensed by the Louisiana Board of Chiropractic Examiners for at least one year.

Proposed law prohibits preceptors from delegating responsibility to render a diagnosis or prescribe a treatment plan to a preceptee and prohibits preceptees performing adjustments or manipulation in accordance with the proposed law from presenting to the public that the preceptee is a licensed chiropractor.

Proposed law provides for preceptees to perform adjustments or manipulation while a preceptor is physically onsite and subjects preceptors and preceptees to disciplinary actions for any violations of the proposed law.
