Abstract: Requires certain factors to be considered in setting bail for hit-and-run driving offenses and directs the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C) to develop a rapid response network to notify officers of hit-and-run offenses.

Present law provides for the crime and penalties of hit-and-run driving.

Proposed law requires judges to consider factors in present law (C.Cr.P. 316) when setting bail for drivers who have committed hit-and-run offenses.

Proposed law requires DPS&C to develop a rapid response network for purposes of notifying law enforcement of hit and run offenses including that an offense occurred, whether there were any injuries in the offense, the appearance of the offending vehicle, and the direction in which it traveled.
