



on election day prohibiting electioneering, dissemination of false voting information, or acts of persuasion targeting voters.

Proposed law requires polling places to display signage explaining voter rights and requires reasonable accommodations for voters with disabilities.

Proposed law requires written notification to voters whose registration status is designated inactive and requires the secretary of state to publish an annual public report on voter roll maintenance activities.

Proposed law provides protections for voter assistance providers acting in good faith and in a nonpartisan manner.

Proposed law authorizes an aggrieved person to seek injunctive relief.

Effective August 1, 2026.
