Jackson-Andrews

Present law defines a "sports wager" or "sports bet" as a sum of money or representation of value risked by a player on an occurrence associated with a sports event for which the outcome is uncertain. Present law further defines the term to include but not be limited to single-game bets, teaser bets, parlay bets, over-under bets, moneyline bets, pools, exchange wagering, in-game wagering, in-play bets, proposition bets, and straight bets.

Proposed law retains present law, but removes "proposition bets" from the definition.

Proposed law defines a "proposition bet" or "prop bet" as a side wager on a part of a sport or athletic event that does not concern the final outcome of the sport or athletic event.

Proposed law defines a "sports micro-bet" as a proposition bet which is wagered live, while a sport or athletic event is ongoing, and concerns the outcome of a play or action occurring in the sport or athletic event.

Present law provides for limitations on wagering.

Proposed law retains present law limitation on wagering and adds sports micro-bets and proposition bets to the list.

Effective August 1, 2026.
