Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to Original Senate Bill
No. 29 by Senator McMath

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 13:5713(C)" insert "and to enact R.S. 13:5713(L)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 6, after "reenacted" insert "and R.S. 13:5713(L) is hereby enacted"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, delete lines 10 and 11, and insert the following:

7 "physician an autopsy in all cases of infants under the age of one year who die unexpectedly
8 without explanation."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 2, after line 19, insert the following:

11 **"(6) The inclusion of an immunization record in any report shall not imply cause**
12 **of death."**

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, after line 20, insert the following:

15 **"L.(1) The death investigation report for any child under the age of fifteen who**
16 **dies unexpectedly without explanation shall include documentation of any**
17 **immunizations administered to the child within ninety days before the child's death,**
18 **as available through the state immunization registry.**

19 **(2) If the coroner finds that the cause of death was Sudden Infant Death**
20 **Syndrome, Sudden Unexpected Infant Death, Sudden Arrhythmic Death Syndrome,**
21 **or Sudden Death in the Young, he shall report the case to the Centers for Disease**
22 **Control and Prevention and the National Institutes of Health's Sudden Unexpected**
23 **Infant Death and Sudden Death in the Young Case Registry.**

24 **(3) The inclusion of an immunization record in any report shall not imply cause**
25 **of death."**
