A RESOLUTION

To designate Wednesday, March 11, 2026, as Funeral Directors Day at the capitol, to recognize National Funeral Directors and Morticians Day, and to commend the Louisiana Funeral Directors Association for the vital services provided by funeral directors and morticians across the state of Louisiana.
