A RESOLUTION

To commend and congratulate Parker Posey on being selected the 2025-2026 "Student of the Year" at Holden High School in Livingston Parish.

WHEREAS, Parker Posey has been selected as the 2025–2026 "Student of the Year" at Holden High School, an honor reserved for a student who exemplifies academic excellence, leadership, character, and service; and

WHEREAS, Parker has distinguished himself as an exceptional scholar, maintaining a 4.0385 grade point average, earning a composite ACT score of 30, and completing thirty-six hours of college credit while still enrolled in high school; and

WHEREAS, Parker has demonstrated remarkable leadership through active involvement in numerous student and civic organizations including Beta Club, Library Club, Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA), 4-H, Future Farmers of America (FFA), and Student Council, where he was selected by peers and faculty to serve in key leadership roles such as FFA Voting Delegate, FCA Executive Leader, and Student Council Executive Officer; and
