8 On page 1, line 14, after "immediately" and before "notify" insert a comma ", " and "or as
9 soon as practicable,"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, at the beginning of line 16, change "(1)" to "(a)"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 1, at the beginning of line 17, change "(2)" to "(b)"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 6

15 On page 1, delete lines 18 through 20 in their entirety and insert

16 "(c) The district attorney.

17 (d) Local media outlets within the parish.

18 (2) The provisions of this Subsection apply to the improper release of an
19 inmate who has been detained or incarcerated on the basis of an arrest or conviction
20 for a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) that is a felony."
