Proposed law amends Louisiana's boards and commissions laws. Proposed law requires the email and telephone information of each member on the website.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law amends the Louisiana's boards and commissions laws (R.S. 49:1302 (D) and R.S. 43:82(5)) to require that the boards and commissions website include each member's private email address or an email address accessible through the board or commission and a direct phone number for each member.

The Division of Administration (DOA) and the Governor's Office of Boards and Commissions report an annual increase of approximately \$2 M for state-issued email accounts and cell phones, totaling \$300 for each member of a board or commission. There are approximately 6,494 board and commission members, resulting in an annual cost of \$1,948,200 (6,494 x \$300). Additionally, the DOA indicates that the Office of Technology Services (OTS) can add required fields to the database website with existing resources. Once fields are available, each board will be responsible for updating the new fields.

Since the proposed law does not require state-issued email accounts or cell phones, the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) cannot independently corroborate the estimated \$2 M estimated by the DOA and the Governor's Office of Boards and Commissions.
