1 AMENDMENT NO. 1**2** On page 1, line 2, after "To" and before "relative to" delete "provide" and insert "repeal R.S.
3 39:100.49 and 100.50,"**4** AMENDMENT NO. 2**5** On page 1, line 3, after "accounts;" and before "to provide" insert "to repeal certain treasury
6 funds;"**7** AMENDMENT NO. 3**8** On page 1, delete line 11 in its entirety and insert the following:**9** "Section 2.(A) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state
10 treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$12,760,000 from the State General
11 Fund (Direct) into the Voting Technology Fund.**12** (B) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
13 hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$5,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct)
14 into the Oil and Gas Regulatory Dedicated Fund Account.**15** (C) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
16 hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$1,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct)
17 into the Carbon Dioxide Geologic Storage Trust Fund.**18** (D) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
19 hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$50,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct)
20 into the State Emergency Response Fund.**21** Section 3.(A) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state
22 treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$900,000 from the State General Fund
23 (Direct) into the Imagination Library of Louisiana Fund.**24** (B) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
25 hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$1,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct)
26 into the Reading Enrichment and Academic Deliverables Fund.**27** (C) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
28 hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$500,000 from the State General Fund (Direct)
29 into the Conservation Incentive Program Account.**30** Section 4. R.S. 39:100.49 and 100.50 are hereby repealed in their entirety.**31** Section 5.(A) The provisions of this Section and Sections 1, 2, and 4 of this Act shall
32 become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not"**33** AMENDMENT NO. 4**34** On page 1, after line 15, insert the following:**35** "(B) The provisions of Section 3 of this Act shall become effective July 1, 2026."
