Amendments proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to
Original House Bill No. 705 by Representative Newell

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 7, delete "(2) Engages in disorderly conduct interrupting" and insert the
3 following:

4 "(2) Disturbs the peace, as provided in R.S. 14:103, in a manner that
5 disrupts"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 2, delete lines 11 through 13 and insert the following:

8 "(4) Engages in public intimidation, as defined in R.S. 14:122, toward a
9 member, or unethical coercion toward a member.

10 B. C. Whoever is found guilty of contempt of the legislature under the
11 provisions of this ~~section~~ Section shall be punished as follows:

12 (1) For a first offense, by a fine of not more than one thousand five hundred
13 dollars.

14 (2) For a second offense, by a fine of not more than two thousand five
15 hundred dollars.

16 (3) For a third and subsequent offenses, by a fine of not more than five
17 thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both."
