Abstract: Authorizes the city of Zachary to use certain inmates to cut grass in certain cemeteries.

Proposed law provides that the city of Zachary may use prison labor to clean and maintain abandoned cemeteries.

Proposed law provides that the use of labor by a prisoner sentenced to a parish prison of any parish of the state, by any court of competent jurisdiction, or a prisoner in a parish prison awaiting transfer to a state correctional facility, to clean and maintain abandoned cemeteries for the city of Zachary, shall be subject to the provisions of present law.

Proposed law provides that, notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the city of Zachary may use funds appropriated by the legislature to maintain a cemetery to pay for prison labor from Dixon Correctional Institute.
