FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL: Provides relative to fire department identification numbers and reporting

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1567(A)(1)(a) and (B), relative to local fire departments; to  
3 require a fire department to obtain an identification number from the National  
4 Emergency Response Information System; to require reporting of all incidents; and  
5 to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:1567(A)(1)(a) and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read  
8 as follows:

9 §1567. Fire departments; fire department identification number; fire reports

10 A.(1)(a) Every municipal fire department, fire protection district, and  
11 volunteer fire department, as recognized by its local governing authority, shall obtain  
12 a fire department identification (FDID) number from the ~~state fire marshal~~ National  
13 Emergency Response Information System.

15 B. Organizations which have been issued an FDID number shall submit  
16 ~~structural fire reports~~ of all incidents electronically pursuant to the standards set by  
17 the state fire marshal.

**Abstract:** Provides that fire departments shall obtain identification numbers from the National Emergency Response System and submit reports of all incidents.

Present law provides that fire departments shall obtain fire department identification numbers from the state fire marshal.

Proposed law changes present law to provide that a fire department shall instead obtain that number from the National Emergency Response Information System.

Present law provides that fire departments shall submit structural fire reports electronically to the fire marshal.

Proposed law changes this requirement to submit reports of all incidents to the fire marshal.
