 Provides relative to fee waivers by the office of motor vehicles for driver's licenses and state identification cards

Proposed law provides for waiver of fees for Class "E" drivers' licenses and state identification cards for homeless persons. Proposed law defines homeless persons as a person living at or below one hundred percent of the federal poverty line or as defined in 42 U.S.C11302. Proposed law provides for proof of homelessness by demonstrating the following: 1. an established homeless shelter, 2. an outreach or supportive service provider, 3. a healthcare provider, 4. a school homeless liaison staffer, 5. a domestic violence service provider.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION
 There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION
 Proposed law will have an indeterminable decrease on SGR collections for OMV. Any potential loss of revenue will likely be small and targeted, relative to total OMV SGR collections. Present law requires a \$25 fee for each application or renewal of a Class "E" driver's license. Proposed law waives fees for the issuance, renewal, or duplication of a Class "E" driver's license for individuals experiencing homelessness. Proposed law further waives fees for state identification cards.
