Abstract: Provides supplemental pay to a person employed by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections as a probation or parole officer

Present law provides extra compensation of \$600 per month to a person employed as a full-time law enforcement officer of a municipality or tribe. Present law specifically excludes an officer employed by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries.

Proposed law provides extra compensation of \$600 per month to a person employed as a probation or parole officer who is a commissioned law enforcement officer employed full-time by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections. Proposed law requires a probation and parole officer to complete and pass a P.O.S.T.-certified training program and complete one year of service in order to be eligible to receive the extra compensation.

Proposed law allows prior service as a full-time law enforcement officer within the state of Louisiana to count towards the one year eligibility requirement.
