Abstract: Allows the removal of clamp-metering devices and limits pumpage fees for parishes with a population of nineteen thousand to nineteen thousand six hundred.

Proposed law allows the removal of clamp-on ultrasonic flowmeters for any parish with a population between 19,000 and 19,600 according to the latest federal decennial census.

Proposed law limits the pumpage fees to \$40 per million gallons for any parish with a population between 19,000 and 19,600 according to the latest federal decennial census.

Redesignates the headings of present law provisions providing for powers and duties of the La. Wildlife and Fisheries Commission.
