2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives on the death of Betty Davis
3 King.

6 2026, of Betty Davis King; and

7 WHEREAS, Betty was born to loving parents and was a cherished wife, mother,
8 grandmother, great-grandmother, and friend whose devotion to family and community
9 earned her the admiration and respect of all who knew her; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. King spent most of her life in her beloved community of Jackson,
11 Louisiana, where she was deeply involved in community service, engaged in many of the
12 ministries of McKowen Baptist Church and Visions Church, and devoted to the East
13 Feliciana School System; and

14 WHEREAS, Betty Davis King was exceptional, capable, conscientious, and
15 compassionate, and all of her actions were guided by three great loves: her relationship with
16 Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior, whom she loved intentionally and unconditionally; her
17 deep devotion to her family; and her abiding love for her hometown of Minden, Louisiana;

20 Earl King; son, Adrian; daughters, Towanda Taylor, Keashu King, and Ashley Armstrong;

2 and a host of sisters, brothers, sisters-in-law, and brothers-in-law; four generations of nieces

4 family and friends in the community she served so well; she will be deeply missed, but the
5 legacy of her loving spirit shall live on in the hearts and minds of those who were privileged
