Thompson

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 133 North in the Village of Oak Ridge, between south of Fluker Lane and the Village of Oak Ridge corporate limits, as the "Erle McKoin 'Niney' Barham Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 133 South in the Village of Oak Ridge, between north of Buck Shepard Road and the Village of Oak Ridge corporate limits, as the "Joseph Sidney Carter Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 134 West in the Village of Oak Ridge, between east of Lake Erwin Road and the Village of Oak Ridge corporate limits, as the "Abner Wimberly Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 134 East in the Village of Oak Ridge, between west of Pipes Lane and the Village of Oak Ridge corporate limits, as the "James Wallace McLendon Memorial Highway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting the hwy. designations provided local or private monies are received by the DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of the signage, not to exceed the sum of \$750 per sign.
